But in the end, it was what Mr. Bradley said that I remember. I can not list all of the amendments by hand, or recite all of Nevada's member's names in government, or talk deeply about the 12th Amendment. I can talk about random factoids that I can not ultimately put into use. I can however acknowledge contemporary problems in society, talk about how those problems came about, and give my opinion on them, and even feel like I am a part of society and that I should do something about said issues. I am not knocking down learning the technical information of how government works, but all of that means nothing if there is no meaning behind it, or the way of using that information to make positions on issues. Someone could know all the facts in the world, but if they do not use that knowledge for anything, it would be useless. This was a problem faced by my high school classmates in our competitions, we knew facts, but not how to apply it to real people. And with Professor Bradley, he knows that learning how to think is a lot more important than learning what to think. Professor Bradley is a very inspirational speaker. You can feel that he really is passionate about political science, and that he wants people to at least recognize their worth and power in society, and not just in the realm of his subject matter. He obviously has opinions about certain issues, but he does a great job of presenting different sides of issues. 

Learning Ratings (Instructor items)







Assessment Ratings (Course items)






